

It's been a busy start to the new year with lots of activity on site. Both Bloor Homes and Crest Nicholson have been busy on their respective development parcels and we are continuing to work with SMBC on the progress of homes at Blythe Valley.

At the end of January, Crest made a further application for housing on another development parcel at the park, which will help to ensure continuity of the overall design and vision for the site.

We are pleased to announce that a new bus service has been set up to serve Blythe Valley Park and the surrounding villages by Transport for West Midlands, commencing service from Sunday 24th February. The new bus route is a seven day a week service – running from 6am to 10pm during weekdays – that will provide more frequent bus travel to and from Blythe Valley Park. CONSTRUCTION UPDATE



Since our last communication in December, we have:

- Installed the tarmac surface to the new estate road towards Kinton Lane.
- Worked on the creation of new football pitches and a public open space in the south.

Current phase of works

- Installation of speed limit signs on Kinton Lane with SMBC.
- Estate road to be tarmacked in its entirety for future development phases.
- Continuation of service and footpath construction.
- Carry out the majority of work to the new balancing ponds.

Next phase of works (February to April 2019)

- The new public open space in the south will be levelled.
- Complete the installation of the balancing ponds.
- Full formation of the new estate road and footpaths.
- Construction of new public walkways across the public open space.
