

## BVP BIKES CODE OF CONDUCT

As a BVP Bike Member, we expect you to not only respect the bikes when using them, but also remember that you will be using the bikes in an active business park environment. Please use this code of conduct as a common sense guide when taking the bikes out and about around the site!

- Blythe Valley Park is a thriving destination, with people coming to the park for work and leisure. Please be mindful of others when using estate roads and footpaths in the country park.
- If a path is busy or congested, please dismount the bike and walk with the bike until the path you wish to use has cleared.
- Safety is key, so please cycle at a steady speed, and slow down when approaching other park users. Please also be aware that the country park is often used for dog walking, so keep an eye out for four legged friends, and slow your pace.
- Our country park is a special space full of nature and wildlife. We want it to remain peaceful and relaxing for the people using it, so please be aware of noise if you are out cycling in a group.
- Remember that the BVP Bikes are a shared park resource. Please treat the BVP Bikes with the consideration you would treat something you owned yourself – so that our park community can continue to use and enjoy them.
