PLANNING APPLICATION FOR PARCEL R



Next phase of development for Bloor Homes

After their ongoing delivery of new homes at Blythe Valley Park, Bloor Homes is preparing plans to bring forward the development of Plot R of the Blythe Valley Park masterplan.

The emerging proposals include:

- 114 new homes
- A range of house sizes, including 1, 2, 3 and 4-bedrooms
- A mixture of house types including apartments, terraced, semi-detached and detached housing
- 25% affordable housing, which will include shared ownership and affordable rented
- Access into the development will be via the newly constructed Spine Road, with pedestrian path links throughout the site
- Planting and landscaping will be provided throughout the development

In order to bring the next phase forward, Bloor Homes will submit a reserved matters application to Solihull Metropolitan Borough Council in the coming weeks. The Council will then carry out a period of consultation before determining the application. Subject to planning approval, construction would commence on site later this year.
